



2021 FINANCIAL OVERVIEW

- 50% of membership revenues (approx. \$29k) went directly into the Aquarium's operating fund.
- There is a category for Gift Shop, which will be removed from later reports, as oversight shifted from FOWA to the Aquarium in 2019.
- FOWA is operating at a deficit, primarily due to loss of revenue streams caused by the pandemic.

- FYE '20 includes 18 months of operations due to change in year end to Dec 31st.
- Special Events revenues decreased due to the cancellation of events including Ke Kani O Ke Kai in 2020 and 2021.
- Program Services expense in FYE '20 includes \$445,000 provided to the Aquarium for operational costs during shutdown
- Contributions & Grants includes SBA PPP Loan proceeds of \$23,000 and \$21,000 in FYE '21 and '20, respectively. Received full forgiveness for both loans.
- Contributions & Grants also includes generous donations from our members.



2022 NOMINATING & GOVERNANCE

FOWA Bylaws Updates:

- First amendment of our bylaws in 20 years adopted October 10, 2022
- Purpose of amendments:
 - Modernize to authorize greener and more efficient practices
 - Ratify and conform to existing standards and practices
- Records and notices can be electronic to save paper
- Records retention practices and policies authorized
- Deleted fixed timing for annual members meeting only in October or November
- Committees report activities to Board without duplicative burden to keep minutes
- Other housekeeping and conforming amendments
